General Description

Nice diversity - 1,160' of elevation with tremendous views and building sites and mixed mature timber, to a series of beaver ponds (great wood duck habitat). County Road 205 offers great access. Feeder branches of Terrapin Creek and the main stream of Camp Creek flow through the property offering potential lake / pond sites. Surrounded by large landowners and bordered by the Talladega National Forest. Deer, turkey, ducks, small game.

Location / Directions:

Eastern Alabama Hill Country - just west of the Alabama / Georgia border.

From I20 West: I20 west from Atlanta, Highway 100 North to Tallapoosa, Georgia. West on Highway 78. Cross Alabama state line. Right on CR 49. Left on CR 205. 1.8 miles to the property line.

From the Marietta / Dallas / Rockmart / Cedartown areas: Highway 278 West. Cross the Alabama line. First left past the state line - CR 69. Right on CR 49. Right on CR 205. 1.8 miles to the property line - gate on right past the property line.
